Helen DeGennaro, the General Manager from Even Stevens, shared about the company and the efforts they make to support the needy in local communities.

A representative from Denver Green Roof Initiative shared about their initiative I-300, which would require buildings over 25,000 sq ft to allocate a certain percentage of their rooftops to solar panels or vegetation. After the presentation, there was time for questions and answers.

Bruce O'Donnell with Starboard Realty presented on behalf of Rocky Mountain Communities. Their Townview at 17th and Hooker St. property is seeking to be rezoned in order to construct their new 5-story senior community building. They are looking at rezoning a much smaller area than before. After the presentation, there was time for questions and answers.

Lastly, there was a presentation about the GO Bond on the ballot this November. The different ballot measures, 2D through 2G, were covered and each measure was summarized.
